

TREE WORKS HELP SHEET

PRE-WORK ADVICE

1. Many customers are unsure what course of action to take - please do ask our advice - tell us what you hope to achieve with regard to the tree's location and its effect on the rest of your property, or your neighbours.
2. We can liaise with neighbours and the local authority, particularly where a Tree Preservation Order is concerned or you live in a Conservation Area.
3. It may be worth considering other surrounding woody vegetation, including shrubs at the same time, as this is key to tree work. By undertaking this work at the same time will help lower the costs in the long run for you.
4. Ask us about replanting and further management.

THE DAY WE DO THE WORK...

1. If the tree work is part of a wider landscaping scheme we strongly urge you to undertake the tree surgery first. It limits costs to you by making the job easier without having to be mindful of freshly planted beds or laid turf.
2. Try not to erect new structures near the tree, to avoid any unavoidable damage.
3. If you could keep access to the garden obstruction free, this will cut down time on our arrival. Don't worry if you can't move anything we will be happy to do this for you - it just adds extra time before we commence.
5. Take pictures of where your potted plants and small features such as bird baths are to help us return your garden to as near original state as possible.
